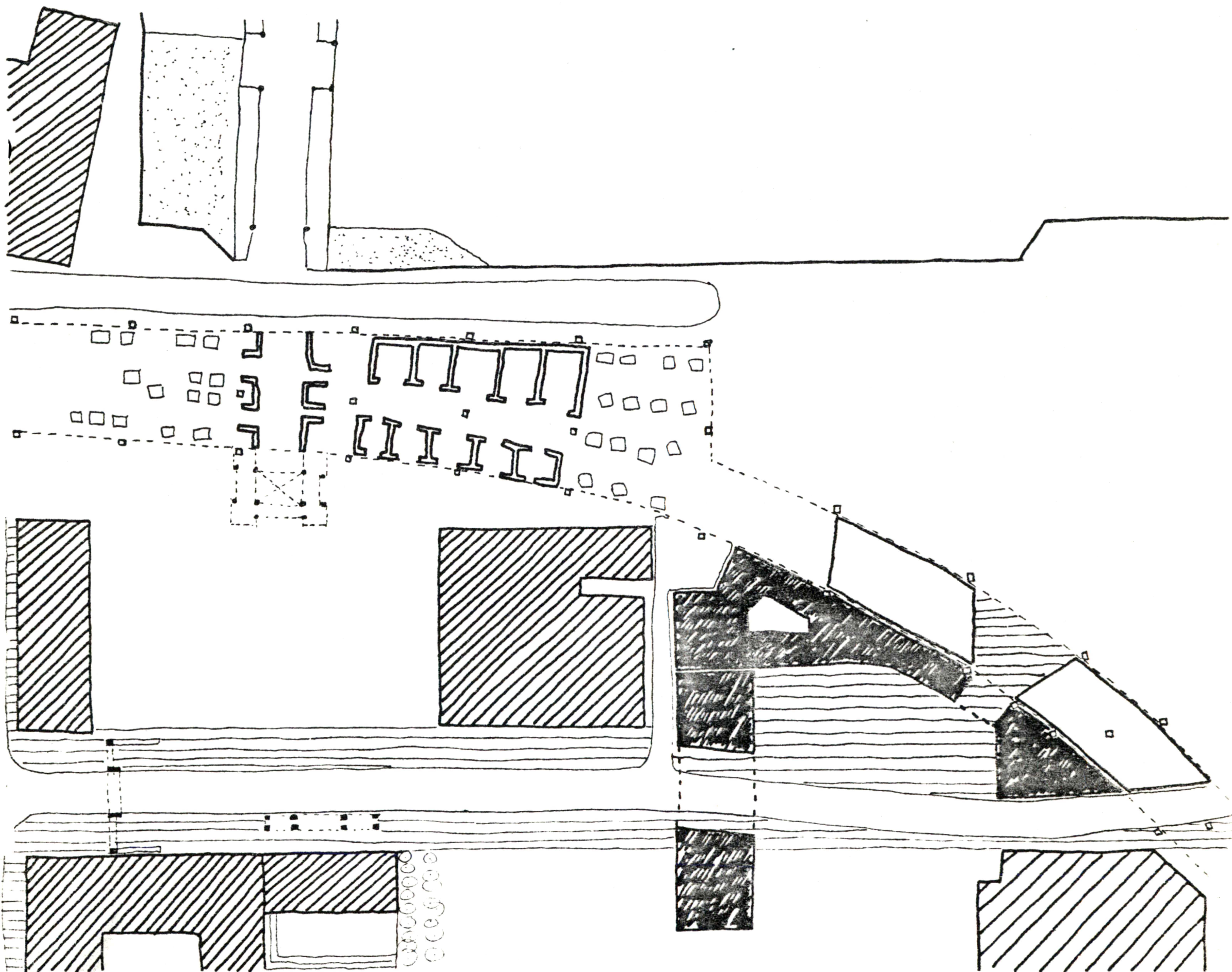

The project is a complex of three buildings, that forms a U shape open space facing S-W.

The first building of the complex, next to the Y.M.C.A. helps to define the pedestrian and car axis between the gate and the building passage.

This passage opens on to a medium size square, which is surrounded by the street and the three buildings. Their height varies from 4-5 stories. Along the long side of the square there is an arcade. Between the ~~other two~~ buildings exists a vaulted gallery under the freeway. It is a point of transition to the other part of the site. Standing there a nice view of the bay and the island can be enjoyed.



This project is composed of two buildings. The relationship between them becomes clear because of their contribution to the formation of the south-west boundary of the main square in such a way, that different levels of proximity on the square are created.

The first building, three storeys high, (facing the square directly), gives the first impression of a loose boundary. It leaves open the view to the second building, which is five storeys high and is located partly behind it forming the last end of the square. Between the two buildings runs the street that crosses the site.

The small building is consisted of offices and workshops for the community newspaper. There is a thoroughfare that crosses the building and gives the opportunity for a glimpse of the square for people walking along Folsom street.

The larger building is consisted of a small experimental theater and restaurant on the ground floor and of offices for the theater actors-, reporters-, and artists-unions on the floors above.

In the middle of this building there is a courtyard, which is reached after stepping, through a covered arcade. This courtyard
