Common land

House+Garden

Place garden and house next to each other, so that both help to form the edge of common land.

Man Garden

Place the garden not fully in the front of the house, not fully in back, but place it in such a way that part of it is adjacent to the common land and part of it is more related to the open land where the view is. The garden should be oriented towards south, or south-east, or south-west.

Consider the shape and the location of the house in relation to the garden and the common land.

Foundation pads

One side of the house has to be adjacent to the common land (maybe its narrower side?)

The house should consist of 2 rectangles the most, not wider than 8 meters (?) wide.

Enclose the part of the garden facing the common land with a wall, which is between 1.2 to 1.8 meters high. *no dimensions*

On the wall which encloses the garden place the entrance door, preferably closer to that end which is closer to the house.

Find the best place in the garden to enter the house, not far from the entrance door to the garden.

Garden Entrance room

Inside the entrance make an entrance room or passage which can easily lead to the inside of the house in all different directions. Try to keep a nice relationship between the garden and the entrance room.

Entrance room Main room

Place the main room close to the entrance room of the house, in such a way that it has light from at least two sides. The ideal situation could be if it could have light from two opposite sides. Also, locate it in such a manner so that it can have a view, or a glimpse of both the garden and the common land.

Main room Secondary room

The secondary room is always placed adjacent to the main room and is rather open to it. It helps to bring more light into the main room, maybe from its opposite ^{side}, when this does not happen. It has an alcove-like relationship to the main room.

The secondary room can be the dining area, or a small study or a guest room, or a family room.

☒ Place a window seat in the main room or in the secondary room. Place it where it seems more appropriate in terms of view and orientation.

Place the kitchen as an extension of the main room, or as separate room by itself; however, place it ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ adjacent to the garden on a sunny spot.

Garden porch

In the garden, where the entrance to the house is, place a porch, It is very important that the porch is rather close, if not adjacent to the kitchen, so that it is easy to carry food outside, and also part of it can be use as an outdoors utility space.

Bedrooms

Bedrooms ~~are~~ either consist a distinct part of the building, ~~be~~ placed on split level in relation to the other part, or ~~in~~ a wing running in right angle to the main part, or ^{may be placed} to the part of the house beyond the kitchen ~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ that is on the opposite side of the house where main and secondary rooms are, or in some cases in both ends of the house.

Bedrooms

Small ^{room} common area around which ~~the~~ bedrooms are clustered

From the entrance there is a clear ^{way} ~~xxx~~ which leads to the ~~xxx~~ small well defined area along which or around which bedrooms are clustered. This is a room that has light from at least one side, and it can be a children's play room, or an adults sitting area or a wide corridor along a balcony.
