

ADDENDUM
TO THE CONTRACT OF MAY 6, 1982
FOR DELAYS IN ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN WORK

Between Gakko Hojin Eishin Gakuen, Keizo Sakaida, Representative (hereinafter called the "Client"), and the Center for Environmental Structure, Christopher Alexander, Representative (hereinafter called the "Architect").

BACKGROUND

According to article 6 of the main contract of May 6, 1982, the Architect and Client have agreed to review the costs incurred by any exceptional delays in the schedule of design work.

ARTICLE 1. For reasons which have been fully explained in the memorandum of January 15, 1984, the Architect has been forced to delay his work by 3.5 months.

In order to compensate the Architect for this extra work, the Client agrees to pay the sum of \$91,000 (this sum is calculated as $3.5 \times \$26,000$).

ARTICLE 2. This payment will be made immediately, upon signing of this addendum.
