

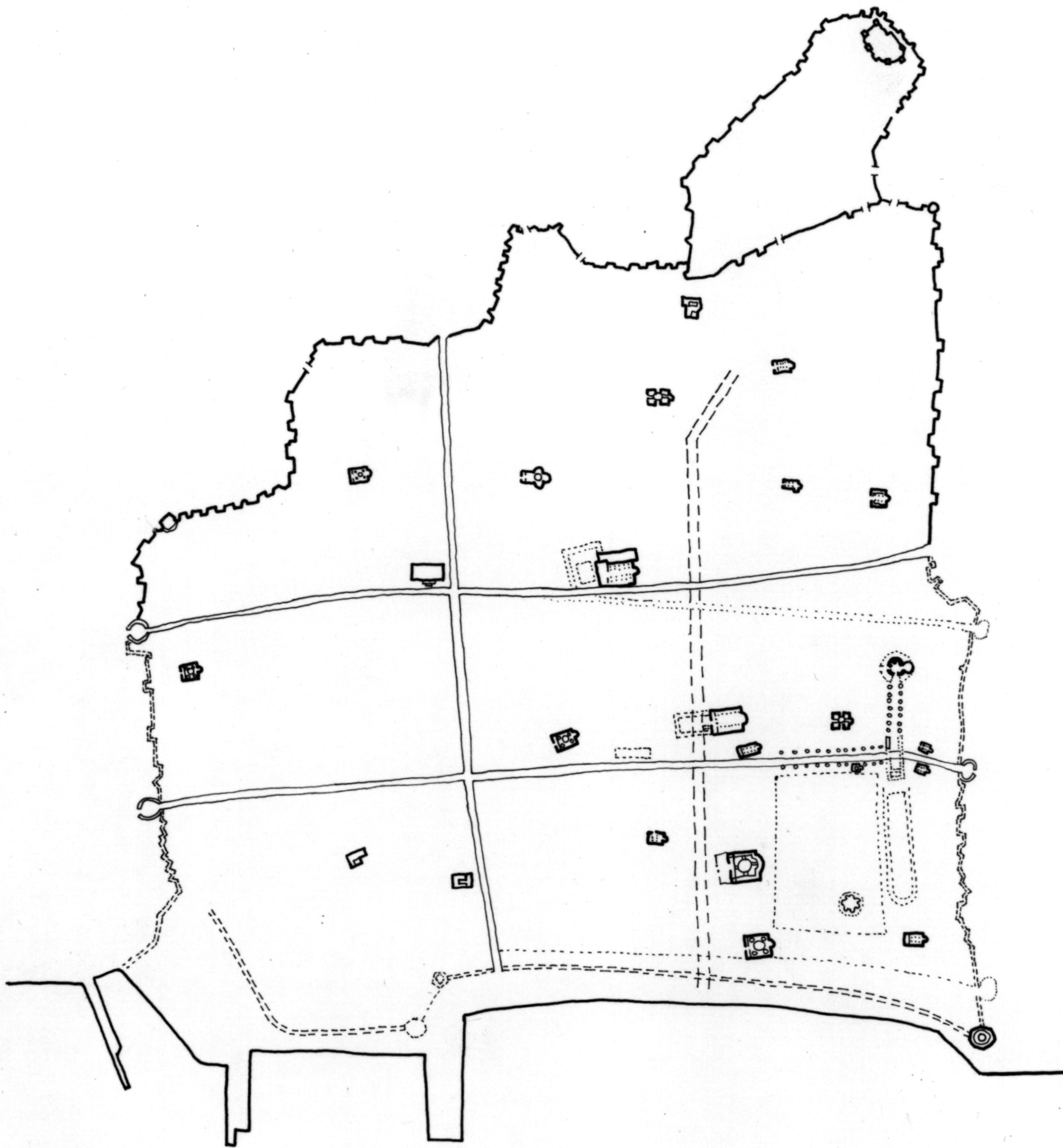

* THESSALONIKI (335 B.C) HAS ALL FUNCTIONS AND ELEMENTS BUT NO HARMONY (CFR. HUMAN BODY)

OLD HISTORIC CENTER (65.000 INH.) IS A POOR AREA WITH LITTLE OR NO INFRASTRUCTURE, MOST OF THE MONEY IS SPENT ON RESTORATION OF EXISTING MONUMENTS.

* CENTERING PROCESS

WE GIVE EACH EXISTING MONUMENT - AS NUCLEUS - A SPECIFIC MAIN FUNCTION AND SURROUND IT WITH ALL OTHER GENERAL FUNCTIONS TO MAKE "COMMUNITIES OF 7000" ALIVE

ON HIGHER LEVELS (PARTS OF THE CITY AS CENTERS, WHOLE CITY AS A CENTER) THESE SPECIFIC MAIN FUNCTIONS ARE IN HARMONY AND CREATE A WHOLE,

ON A LOWER LEVEL THE SPECIFIC AND GENERAL FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMUNITY NUCLEUS SUPPORT AND FEED NEIGHBORHOOD ACTIVITY NODES, WITH MORE EMPHASIS IN THE LATTER ON DAILY LIFE, WORK ENTERTAINMENT, HOUSING

* ON EACH LEVEL THE BASIC IDEA OF CENTERS GUIDES US IN SELECTING AND APPLYING THE RIGHT PATTERNS TO LET THE CENTERS GENERATE LIFE AND CREATE HARMONY

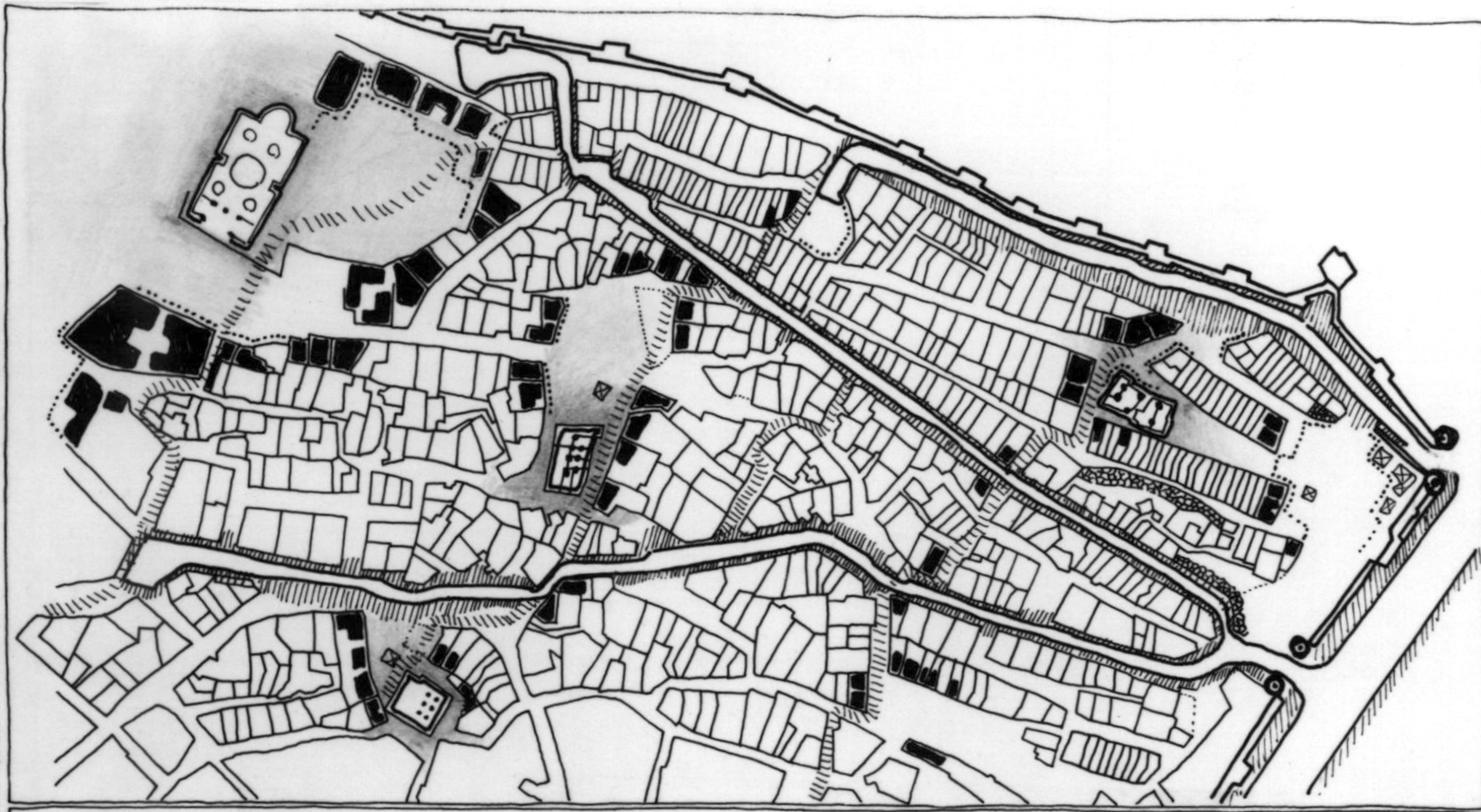

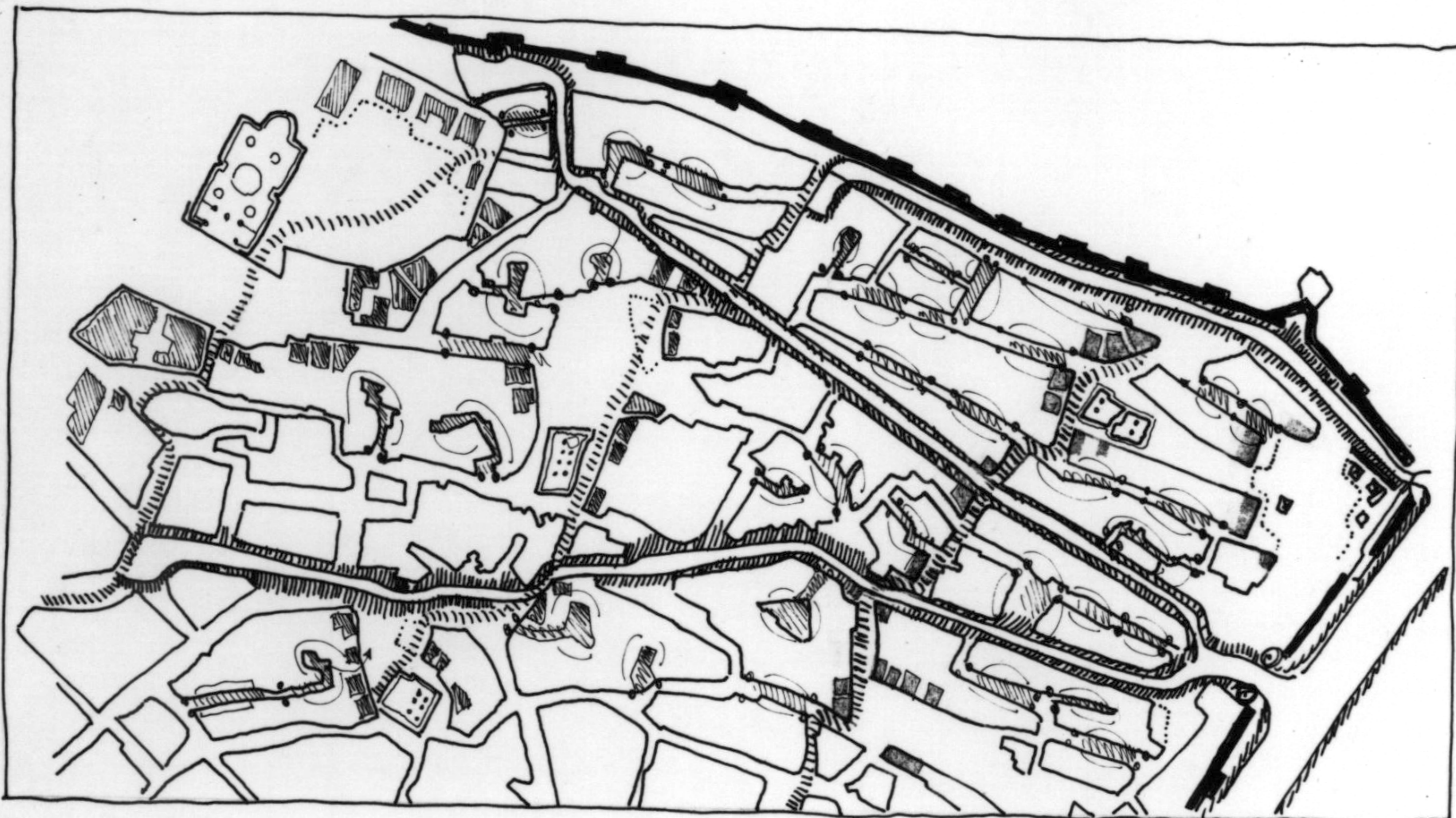
