

35. HOUSEBOAT-PIER



I IMAGINE A PIER FOR HOUSEBOATS IN CONNECTION WITH HUBERT'S FISHER-BOAT PIER. However, this pier is a floating pier rather than a fixed one. A visit to Sausalito has shown, that the feeling of 'being on the water' is essential. As well, the formation of clusters seems to be important, so that the pier, in fact, will be broken down into a set of floating piers connected by "bridges." Another characteristic which seems to be important, is the distribution of boat sizes; therefore it is envisaged to have different sizes of boats. The type of houseboat which I imagine for this area are more in the nature of normal boats rather than houses on the water.
