


THE AREA AT THE SOUTH-EAST CORNER OF THE 'MAIN PLACE' HAS BEEN OF SPECIAL INTEREST FOR ME. Together with the Library this configuration creates a small place, where one can sit and eat on the terrace of the restaurant. A semi-public thoroughfare through the restaurant connects this place with the waterfront walkway. On top of the restaurant apartments will be provided.






SITE PLAN






EAST ELEVATION RESTAURANT






WEST ELEVATION












EAST ELEVATION LONG BUILDING
