DIAGNOSIS

INSTEAD OF USING A MASTER PLAN, THE PEOPLE OF THE COMMUNITY REGULARLY USE THE PATTERN LANGUAGE TO DIAGNOSE THEIR PRESENT ENVIRONMENT. THE DIAGNOSIS TELLS THEM WHERE IT IS MOST DISEASED, AND WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE TO MAKE IT BETTER.

THE DIAGNOSIS IS ALWAYS BASED ON PATTERNS. NEW GROWTH IS ALWAYS ADDED IN SUCH A WAY AS TO CURE THE DISEASES REVEALED BY THE DIAGNOSIS. YOU BUILD IN THOSE PARTS OF THE TOWN WHICH ARE FUNCTIONALLY IN THE WORST CONDITION.

INSTEAD OF TRYING TO DECIDE NOW, IN 1972, WHAT MARSTA SHOULD BE LIKE IN 1990, YOU ACCEPT THE FACT THAT IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO TELL, BECAUSE IT ALL DEPENDS ON THE PROBLEMS WHICH REVEAL THEMSELVES AS THE TOWN GROWS.

THE TOWN WHICH WILL FINALLY BE HERE
IN 1990 CANNOT BE PREDICTED NOW. IT
WILL GROW OF ITS OWN ACCORD, UNDER
THE IMPETUS OF THE PATTERN LANGUAGE
AND THE WAY THAT THE PEOPLE OF MARSTA
INTERPRET THE PATTERNS.
